



DAY 1- ARRIVAL IN KAZIRANGA – GATEWAY TO THE WILD

Your journey into Assam's natural beauty begins with your arrival at Guwahati Airport, followed by a scenic drive to the Central zone of Kaziranga National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its vast grasslands and iconic wildlife. Once you arrive, settle into your accommodation and take a moment to relax and soak in the peaceful surroundings.

In the evening, meet fellow wildlife enthusiasts and connect with the naturalist who will guide you throughout the expedition. Enjoy a visit to Orchid Park, where you'll experience Assam's cultural heritage through captivating traditional music and dance performances.




DAY 2- EXPLORING KAZIRANGA'S KOHORA RANGE

Start your day with an exciting jeep safari through the Kohora range of Kaziranga. As the sun rises, watch the grasslands come alive with sightings of the iconic one-horned rhinoceros, wild water buffalo, and a variety of bird species.

After a relaxing break, head into the Burapahar range for an afternoon safari. Here, you may spot elephants and other wildlife along the riverbanks. The day promises a stunning blend of nature's sights and sounds, perfect for photography and wildlife observation.




DAY 3- MORNING AND AFTERNOON SAFARIS IN AGARATOLI AND BAGORI RANGES

The morning calls for an early safari in the Agaratoli range. Here, the park's quieter paths offer a unique perspective, with opportunities to observe herds of deer, elephants, and possibly a tiger in the distance.

In the afternoon, set out for the Bagori range safari. Known for its water bodies and dense forest patches, this part of Kaziranga is ideal for spotting larger groups of wildlife and soaking in the symphony of the wild.

DAY 4- FINAL SAFARI AND JOURNEY TO TEZPUR

Start your day with a light breakfast before setting out on a captivating birding trail around Kaziranga. Witness the delight in the sights and sounds of the region's unique avian species as you wander through nature's sanctuary.

In the afternoon, embark on an exhilarating river safari. Keep your eyes out for a chance to witness the endangered Gangetic dolphins gracefully playing in the water—a truly magical encounter. As the day winds down, journey to the charming town of Tezpur. Here, a serene stay in a cozy local hotel promises the perfect retreat to relax and rejuvenate.

DAY 5- INTO THE WILDS OF NAMERI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, set out for Nameri National Park, where a guided trek awaits. This serene forest is a paradise for birdwatchers, home to species like the great hornbill and various kingfishers. The trek allows for intimate encounters with the park's flora and fauna.

Return for a leisurely afternoon at your hotel or an optional walk along the Jia Bhoroli River, enjoying the calm before your final wildlife experiences.



DAY 6 - BIDDING FAREWELL







General Refund Policy

45+ days prior to starting date of the trip – 100% refund of the total trip cost 30-44 days prior to starting date of the trip – 75% refund of the total trip cost 15-29 days prior to starting date of the trip – 50% refund of the total trip cost 8 -14 day prior to starting date of the trip – 25% refund of the total trip cost 7 days or less prior to starting date of the trip – No refund

What time does the trip start and end?

This trip is planned in a way that the group (guests+team) will be departing from Guwahati airport strictly by Noon.

Please ensure that you book your flights accordingly. If need be, we suggest flying in a day early.

What time do we need to book our flights?

On Day 1, you will need to land in Guwahati by 11:45 am at the latest. Our trip will start from Guwahati Airport by Noon. On Day 6, you must book a return flight any time after 1:30 pm.

What is your Cancellation Policy?

What happens if someone books their flights before reserving a slot with us and we are sold out?

It is important to note that booking flights before reserving a slot with us does not guarantee availability. In the event that we are sold out, we cannot be held responsible for any inconvenience caused.

What type of properties are we staying at?

We'll be staying at simple homestays, campsites, guesthouses and resorts throughout the trip. None of the properties on the trip are boutique/luxurious. They are all clean, comfortable and hygienic and have been vetted by our team! Note - Some of the properties have different categories of rooms and the allocation of rooms will be random and at CHaloHoppo's discretion.

What are the current road conditions and driving time?

The roads from Guwahati to Kaziranga are in good condition with beautiful countryside views. Chances of motion sickness are much lesser than usual.

What are the meals that are provided and what about the ones not included?

Breakfast will be served at the properties that we are staying at. Most of these places provide standard breakfast that ranges from Poori + Vegetables to Sandwiches, Bread, Butter, and Omelettes.

The lunch that is included in the Day 5 will be an outdoor lunch which will consist of rice, chicken, local fish, lentils, salad and vegetables procured from local villages.

Other meals can be ordered at the place of stay or nearby restaurants. You have options of all cuisines in Kaziranga.

Room sharing

Rooms are shared on twin sharing basis. In case you are a solo traveller, you will be paired up with another solo traveller of the same gender. For those of you are interested in a single room, we can arrange this at an additional cost.

How much money should we carry?

While most of your expenses are taken care of, an additional Rs. 1,000 per day (upper limit) would be more than enough for all your expenses. You can take a look at our Exclusions to get a better understanding of how much money you may need.

What are some things I should carry?

Once you sign up for the trip, we will be sending you a detailed list of Things to Carry for the season!

Why is there no elephant safari included in the cost?

We do not include elephant safaris in our Kaziranga tours as part of our commitment to ethical wildlife tourism. Instead, we offer alternative wildlife viewing experiences that align with our values of conservation and responsible tourism.
